08/09 District Goals

1. Increase by 3 % the number of 12th grade students who are eligible to apply directly to a four year college or university (A-G) and improve performance data (API, SAT, ACT, and Advanced Placement/International Baccalaureate) in relationship to similar schools.
2. Develop and implement two or more programs of study at each site, increasing the numbers of CTE courses that fulfill A-G requirements and/or CTE Advisory Committee (CTEAC) quality indicators.
3. Analyze, evaluate and revise our current district end-of-course common assessments and develop new assessments in five additional core academic areas. (Eng. 10, U.S. History, Spanish 2, Geometry, and Chemistry)
4. Decrease by 5% the number of students receiving Ds and Fs in English 9, Algebra I, and Geometry courses through implementation of targeted interventions.
5. Develop and implement a master plan for professional development based on national standards.
 - Organize all teachers, administrators, and the District Office into professional learning communities (PLCs) who measure progress through improvement in student achievement.
 - Support adult learning and collaboration through providing quarterly training in effective leadership practices, facilitation of professional learning communities, and research based approaches to instructional improvement.
 - Identify and train two PLC expert facilitators at each site.
